- Set parental controls on your home broadband.
- Remember that children can gain access to the internet through laptops, PCs, tablets, smart phones, and TVs.
- Set passwords on all your internet-enabled devices and make sure that you do not share these with your child.
  - Only allow children to access the internet in family areas. This way you can keep an eye on what your child is doing.
- Set the home screen browser to a child friendly site that your child enjoys.

Remember that the internet is an amazing tool that will be a huge part of your child's life. Encourage your child to ask if they are unsure and never talk to people they don't know. Educating your child on how to stay safe online will keep them safe now and in the future.
